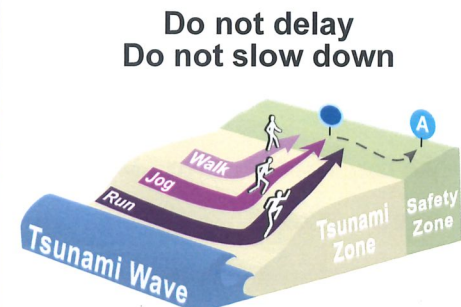

Walk: >1.5 mph | Jog: > 4 mph | Sprint: > 5.5 mph
Speed is based on starting to evacuate 10 minutes after the start of the earthquake

1. Find the nearest color and road to your location
2. Maintain speed shown by route color
3. Use community evacuation zones and arrows to determine fastest evacuation route
4. If you are aware of a more direct route, take it!

- Safety destination
Out of tsunami zone
- Community evacuation zone
Nearest exit destination for a defined area
- Bridge failure
Non-earthquake retrofitted bridges assumed to fail
- Assembly site
- Tsunami zone
