BOIL WATER NOTICE LIFTED

Between April 4th and 5th an unexpected break in a city water line potentially led to harmful bacteria being present in the water supply. The Port Orford Public Works department has repaired the break and sent water samples for testing.

The test results have shown that the water is free from harmful bacteria.

The affected area was limited to the following areas: Idaho between 10th and 13th Street and Hamlet.

Customers in the affected area no longer need to boil their water.

The reason for this outage was a line break, which affected an estimated 100 connections.

Fixing the outage required Port Orford Public Works to take the following actions: repairing and repressuring the broken line and testing the water to ensure it contains no harmful bacteria.

This Notice was hand-delivered to affected residents and published online on the following date: 4/9/2026, after testing showed the water was free from contamination.

This boil water advisory is a precaution to limit the health risks to our citizens. Customers should follow the information contained in this advisory.

The City of Port Orford thanks its citizens for their patience while the line was repaired and the water tested.
