**BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING!**

This interruption in service is due to a loss of pressure caused by a water main break, which means potentially harmful bacteria could be present in the water supply. If these bacteria are present, they could make you sick and are a particular concern for people with weakened immune systems.

Public Works is currently resolving this issue by repairing the line.

**DO NOT DRINK YOUR WATER WITHOUT  
BOILING IT FIRST.**

Customers should bring water to a rolling boil for one full minute, allow the water to cool, and store the cooled water in a clean container with a cover.

Customers should use boiled water that has cooled or bottled water for:

- Drinking
- Preparing food and baby formula
- Brushing teeth
- Making ice
- Washing fruits and vegetables
- Cleaning food-prep areas

**This boil water advisory is a precaution to limit the health risks to our citizens. Customers should follow the information contained in this advisory.**
